A Cardus study estimates the value of religion to Canadian society at over \$67 billion annually—a vital force in our nation's well-being.



In FY24, 82% of Expenses went to Program Activities.





CANADA'S CHRISTIAN TALK SHOW SINCE 1977

100 Huntley Street continues to be a unifying force in Christian media, connecting Canadians coast to coast with the transformative message of Jesus. Through compelling storytelling and on-location episodes from Newfoundland and Alberta, the program reflects the heart of Canadian faith, culture, and communitu.

In FY24, 100 Huntley Street addressed vital national issues—from wildfire relief efforts to conversations on affordable housing, mental health, and the growing concerns around Medical Assistance in Dying (MAiD). The program also highlighted stories of baptism, international impact through Nigeria feeding programs, and celebrated arts and culture, including special coverage of JUNO Week and gospel music nominees.

Viewers were inspired by interviews with Christian voices like Sadie Robertson and Jonathan Roumie (*The Chosen*), along with biblical insights and expert advice on topics such as anxiety—offering hope and wisdom for daily life.

100 Huntley Street airs weekdays in primetime on YES TV, with additional coverage on NTV, Global Thunder Bay, CHEK, and Miracle Channel.





In FY24, Royal Anthems hosted its first songwriting camp at the Crossroads Unity Commons in Burlington, ON. Twentu-two worship leaders from diverse church backgrounds across Canada gathered for a time of prayer, worship, and collaboration—co-writing 16 original songs, capturing 4 live music videos, and releasing 4 debut singles that summer. By Spring 2025, Royal Anthems music has been accessed by over 1,600 churches globally, including a YouTube cover of Thank You from a church in Jakarta, Indonesia—evidence that a sound born in Canada is now echoing worldwide.





A MIRACLE **BEHIND THE LINES**

In FY24, Crossroads' 24/7 Prayer Centre faced a critical moment. With just 30 days' notice, we were informed our phone provider had been sold—and costs were about to triple.

For a ministry that had served nearly **14 million** people at that time, the surprise increase would have been unsustainable had we not already been preparing for what came next.

Thanks to God's provision, proactive planning, and a faithful partner who believes in the mission, our team had already begun modernizing equipment and building a custom, in-house call platform. Just in time, we flipped the switch—seamlessly continuing prayer support for those in need.

That launch marked the beginning of the Anyone Pray platform—expanding our reach and empowering more believers to stand in the gap through prayer.

It was no coincidence. This moment affirmed God's leading and renewed our team's sense of mission and momentum.

Meeting the Need for Prayer in a Post-Pandemic World

t Crossroads, we believe no one should ever have to pray alone. That's why the Crossroads Prayer Centre—open 24 hours a day, 7 days a week—has been the heartbeat of our ministry for over four decades. Every call is a sacred connection, offering a listening ear, a compassionate heart, and an invitation for God's presence to enter life's hardest moments.

In recent years, God stirred our hearts to do more. Following the COVID-19 pandemic, anxiety and loneliness have reached epidemic levels in Canada. Churches and ministries are seeing rising needs, but struggling to keep up. The Flourishing Congregations Institute reports 40% of Canadian pastors have seriously considered stepping away due to burnout. While the desire to care for people has never been greater, the capacity to do so has never felt more stretched.

At the same time, Crossroads was experiencing a challenge of our own: the Prayer Centre's legacy technology wasn't built to scale with the growth we envisioned. We needed to innovate to meet the need.

That's when we launched Anyone Pray—a ministry overflow solution and outreach tool powered by Crossroads Prayer Centre.

Anyone Pray launched in FY24 as a soft pilot with six churches. It offers organizations—churches, nonprofits, schools, and even businesses—the ability to open their own dedicated 24/7 prayer line, with all calls answered by Crossroads' trained prauer volunteers.



By Spring 2025, Anyone Pray has grown to 41 subscriber partners—39 in Canada and 2 in the U.S.A.—and the impact is spreading:

- A business owner began stapling prayer cards to customer receipts.
- A hospital requested posters for palliative care units.
- A community TV station began airing Anyone Pray prayer line spots.

Behind the scenes, we built and launched a new custom prayer platform—designed from the ground up to handle high call volumes, route calls

securely, and empower our prayer team with real-time tools. This technology now powers all Anyone Pray lines and the entire Crossroads Prayer Centre.

We also celebrated our 14 millionth prayer call and welcomed new volunteerstrained and ready to stand in the gap for others.

We're just getting started.

Anyone Pray is opening doors across Canada for people to experience the presence of God through prayer. And because of your support, more Canadians now have someone to go to God with—day or night.

In a hurting world, this ministry is a living reminder: You are not alone. Prayer is always within reach. And yes—anyone can pray.

POWER IN UNITY

When We Are Brought to Complete Unity, the World Will Know...

Canada is experiencing deep spiritual and cultural fragmentation. Many believers feel isolated, churches are stretched thin, and ministries often work in silos—limiting our collective impact. Without unity in prayer, worship, and innovation, the witness of Christ's love risks being diminished. In May 2024, Crossroads launched the 3-year vision campaign Ignite Hope: Power in Unity—uniting believers through prayer, worship, and innovation, based on John 17:23.

Year 1 Highlights

- Anyone Pray: 41 new ministries subscribed to 24/7 prayer lines; 89 new volunteers
- Royal Anthems: 11 original songs released, a national songwriting camp held, and a YouVersion miniseries launched.


